

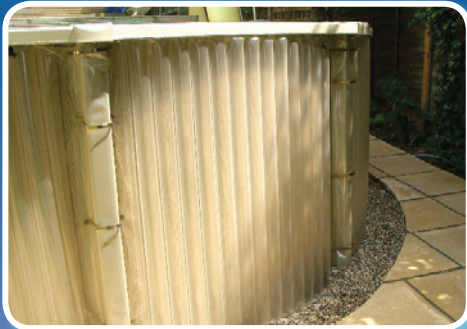

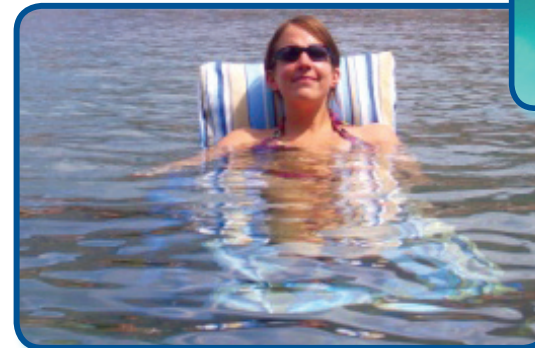

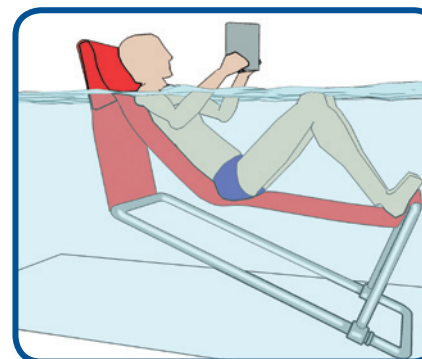
Sea Hammock

- Turns your swimming pool into something you can relax in with friends like a Spa
- Lets you get out of the sun, lay out and cool off in the sea or swimming pool
- Enables you to read a book in the swimming pool or sea
- Immerses your whole body, not just your bottom, as with floating pool chairs mattresses or “hammocks”
- By slight neck pressure or pulling on the main frame you can set up a rocking motion.
- Excellent for gentle trunk bending exercises that can help ease muscle and joint problems
- Easy to get on or off
- Lay on your front or back or sit up

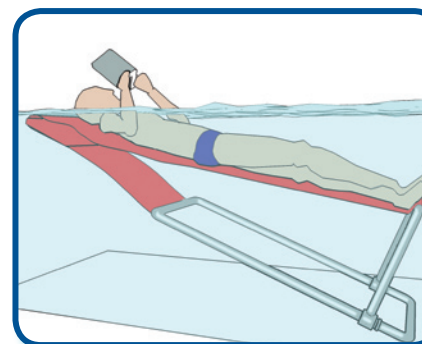

Sea-Hammock is a lightweight plastic frame with a fantastically comfortable adjustable mesh or acrylic canvas cover that lets you lay out front or back with your body completely submerged, in a swimming pool or in the shallows of the sea. You can lie there totally relaxed, just rocking up and down, or possibly reading a book. It offers gentle exercise in warm water:- which many people will find very beneficial.

Sea-Hammock's frame is comprised of pvc tubes. The frame can be assembled or broken apart by a few blows with the palm of your hand. This makes it easy to transport.

The cover has a polyurethane buoyancy bag contained in a floating pillow. The amount of buoyancy can be adjusted by means of a lifejacket inflator valve. A flap extends from the bottom of the pillow to the top rail of the main frame to which it is attached by means of a zip. A sling extends from the bottom of the front of the buoyancy pillow to the arm of the mainframe. The bottom of the sling comprises 4 zipped pockets, and the length of the sling can be adjusted by zipping onto the mainframe arm the zipped pocket that best suits your body height.

In use, the bottom of the mainframe will rest on the sea or pool bottom, whilst the top of the frame will be supported by the buoyancy pillow. The frame is self-adjusting for water depths between about 0.8m and 1.5m (the angle the mainframe makes with the sea or pool bottom just becomes more or less acute). The corners of the frame have holes in them so that the frame will fill with water and sink.

The mainframe measures approximately 1.1m x 0.6m and the mainframe arm approx 0.6m x 0.6m. The frame weighs approximately 4 kg and the cover 1 kg. It is intended for confident swimmers 14 years of age or over.
